Kit and Club Wear Policy

Our kit policy sets out our commitment and desire to maintain a consistent aesthetic and the “one club” ethos throughout **Whinmoor Warriors ARLFC** and all operational age groups.

Kit and Matchday Wear

The below sets out the key principles for kit and matchday wear:

- All club specific attire to be worn on matchdays must be from the official supplier.
- The club's official supplier for kit and matchday wear for 2026-2028 is *Ravensport*.
- A list/suite of standardised matchday wear, available to purchase, is to be produced/ developed which will include the following as a minimum: Post-match Presentation Polo, Hoodie, Pre-Match Jersey. Additional items may be added/included. Should items of this nature be required and procured then this list is to be used across all age groups on matchdays.
- All ordering to be done via the committee using the order form attached. The introduction of a robust ordering process will hopefully go some way to reduce and eliminate errors encountered previously. This will be discussed and rolled out with Team Manager's and *Ravensport*.

Training Wear

The below sets out the key principles for training attire:

- Club specific training wear is not mandatory, however should teams wish to obtain training items then this will be available from the club's official supplier.
- The supplier for training wear for 2026-2028 is *Ravensport*.
- A list/suite of training wear, available to purchase, is to be produced/ developed which will include the following as a minimum Quarter Zip Top, Round Neck T-Shirt, Shorts. Additional items may be added/included.
- All ordering to be done via the committee using the order form attached. The introduction of a robust ordering process will hopefully go some way to reduce and eliminate errors encountered previously. This will be discussed and rolled out with Team Manager's and *Ravensport*.

Special (One Off) Kits and Leisurewear

We understand that for special events (Butlins etc) teams wish to use a kit with an alternative design for the event and we fully support this, and as such teams attending such events can do so with a specially designed "special/one off" kit adhering the following regulations:

- Designs can be original/unique/funky in appearance (akin to what SL teams do for Magic Weekend) however the main colour scheme for the kit must be in keeping with the club colours of Royal Blue and Yellow.
- The kit can be sourced using an alternative supplier to the kit and matchday wear.
- However, all teams representing **Whinmoor Warriors ARLFC** at the same event are to do so in the same kit/attire, produced by the same supplier in order to maintain the consistent aesthetic and "one club" ethos. This has been successfully undertaken in previous years with all associated teams coming together to organise (three teams in three different kits, for example will not be accepted/tolerated).
- Designs are to be run past the committee (akin to 2025) prior to placing the order.
- Any and all items procured as a "special" for an associated event are not to be worn on official matchdays. We request that only attire from the official matchday wear supplier is worn.
- The above rule is relaxed for training sessions.

Additional Club Wear and Sundries

A selection of additional club specific items are available to purchase from the official club supplier including but not limited to Long Touchline coat, Windbreaker Jacket, Towel, Bootbag. Additional items may be added/include.

The club specific website will be updated in line with 2026 range.
